Given the ever-growing number of datasets available online and data collection tools, like those mentioned at GeOnG in 2010 (From the field to the floor), and means of access and store data, such as cloud solutions covered in 2012 (From the cloud to the field), we now face a situation never seen before: large amounts of data become available within days- or even within hours- of an emergency onset and numerous NGOs open up their data to all. This year's theme will therefore be an opportunity to learn more about data analysis tools, to discuss successful experiences and issues faced.
